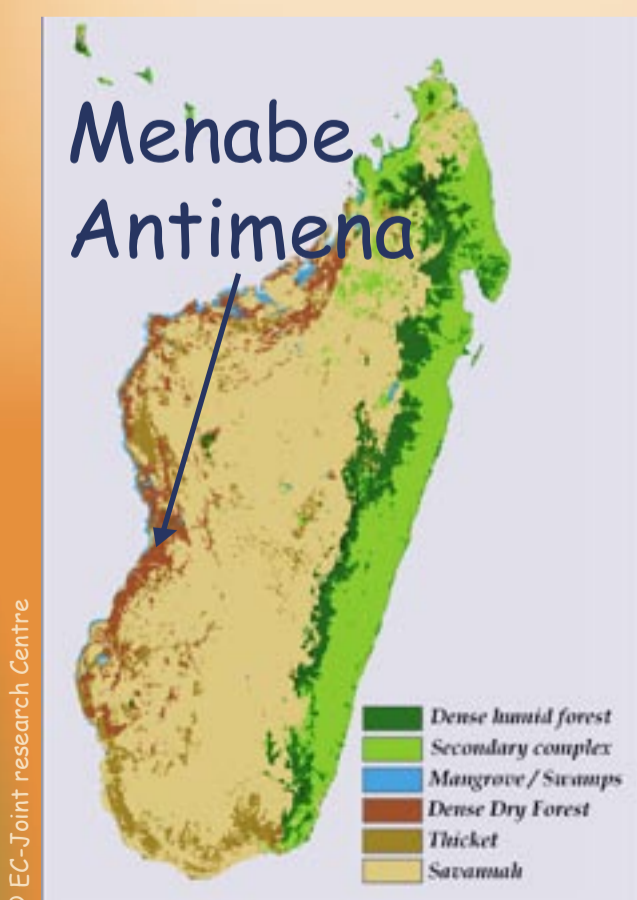
Reniala *Adansonia grandidieri*
